



The MTC Scholarship Guidelines

Approved at the 9th MTC Administrative Meeting on May 17, 2016 (Academic Year 2015)

1. The MTC Scholarship (hereinafter referred to as the Scholarship) is offered by the Mandarin Training Center of National Taiwan Normal University (hereinafter referred to as the MTC) to encourage current MTC students in good standing and passionate about learning Chinese to continue their studies at the MTC.
2. Source of Funding: The Ministry of Education (MOE) and MTC
3. Number of Recipients: To be determined by the funding available each year
4. Scholarship Duration: One Term (three months)
5. Scholarship Amount: One term's tuition of Regular Class
6. Application Period: To be announced
7. Eligibility:
Current MTC students who are not recipients of any other scholarships awarded by the Taiwanese government during the scholarship duration and who meet the following requirements may apply:
 - 1) Grade
 - A. Level 1~5 students obtaining an average grade of 90 or above for the past two consecutive terms
 - B. Level 6~9 students obtaining an average grade of 80 or above for the past two consecutive terms
 - 2) Attendance
 - A. Regular Class students whose absence hours do not exceed 12 hours per term
 - B. Intensive Class students whose absence hours do not exceed 15 hours per term
8. Application Procedure:
Submit the following documents to the MTC Student Counseling Division:
 - 1) Application Form
 - 2) MTC Attendance Record
 - 3) Other documents: Copy of TOCFL Score Report, copy of certificate for speech or singing contest, copy of certificate of participation in activities, etc.
9. Review Procedure:
 - 1) Preliminary Review: Perusal of application materials
 - 2) Final Review: Selection by the MTC Scholarship committee
10. Scholarship Cancellation:
The Scholarship shall be cancelled should any of the following occurs within the scholarship award duration:
 - 1) The recipient fails to achieve an average term grade of 80.
 - 2) The recipient misses more than 12 hours of class in a single month.
 - 3) The recipient fails to complete at least 10 hours of volunteer service at MTC.
11. The MTC Scholarship Guidelines are officially implemented following the review and approval at the MTC Administrative Meeting. Any future revision shall follow the same procedure.
